Regulatory changes on the horizon

Assuring compliance has become the number one issue for those involved with invoicing. Global Tax Authorities are moving towards closing their tax gaps, partly due to implementing plans for a post-Covid recovery.

To close these tax gaps, governments worldwide are mandating networks and clearance models, which create a whole new set of challenges. Government requirements and delivery deadlines vary from country to country, adding to the complexity. To stay on top of these requirements, departments including legal, operations, and finance need to be in sync, and importantly not wait but to act now.

In addition to these challenges, organisations that do business in the EU are preparing for VAT in the Digital Age (ViDA) proposals, which will replace after-the-fact tax filings with near real-time e-reporting. This will hasten the introduction of domestic e-invoicing and e-reporting mandates.

Organisations are simultaneously focusing on government mandates while addressing technology and business challenges, including the ongoing adoption of AI for smarter decision-making and efficiency, as well as managing the evolution of accounts payable (AP) as a strategic stakeholder.




All of this represents a significant change for many organisations, both legally and operationally, with fines applicable for those failing to issue or receive e-invoices. Organisations have two options: implement point solutions or adopt an Al-driven platform approach. While an invoice-only point solution might appear more affordable, it fails to drive value throughout accounts payable (AP) and the wider organisation. Opting for an Al-driven platform approach enables strategic invoicing, provides greater insights, and de-risks your end-to-end procurement operations.

A Complex Marketplace

The approach taken and deadline for delivery by different governments to invoice compliance varies wildly. Shown below is an overview of the proposed e-invoice implementation timeline for a selection of countries.



Four government approaches to e-invoicing mandates



Decentralised Continuous Transactional Controls (CTCs)

Allows for a number of certified service providers in the market, alongside government, to provide a free portal for small and medium enterprises. The portal will validate and ensure integrity of invoice data to facilitate compliance. A subset of invoice data is reported to the tax authority.

> Country example: France



Centralised Model

A centralised invoicing platform governed by the relevant national tax authority is used to approve invoice transactions. A unique code, ID, QR will be added to the invoice document to make it a legal tax document.

> Country examples: Poland



Interoperability model (i.e. PEPPOL)

Certified service providers operate a standardised process that allows for the exchange of transaction types i.e. orders, delivery notes, status messages.

Country examples: This model is commonplace in Business to Government transactions throughout EU; promoted in **Australia**, **New Zealand and Singapore**



Real time reporting

Rather than an e-invoicing mandate, this is a requirement for vendors to report fiscal data to the respective tax administration in real time/near real time. Real time reporting is typically introduced ahead of a mandate or at the same time.

Country examples: Spain, Hungary

Issuance & Clearance where Coupa generates the legal invoice on behalf of the supplier and clears it with the country's tax authority if applicable



Clearance Validation where the supplier clears the e-invoice outside of Coupa, and Coupa validates this after the invoice is cleared

Clearance Retrieval where Coupa retrieves cleared invoices from the tax authority system
